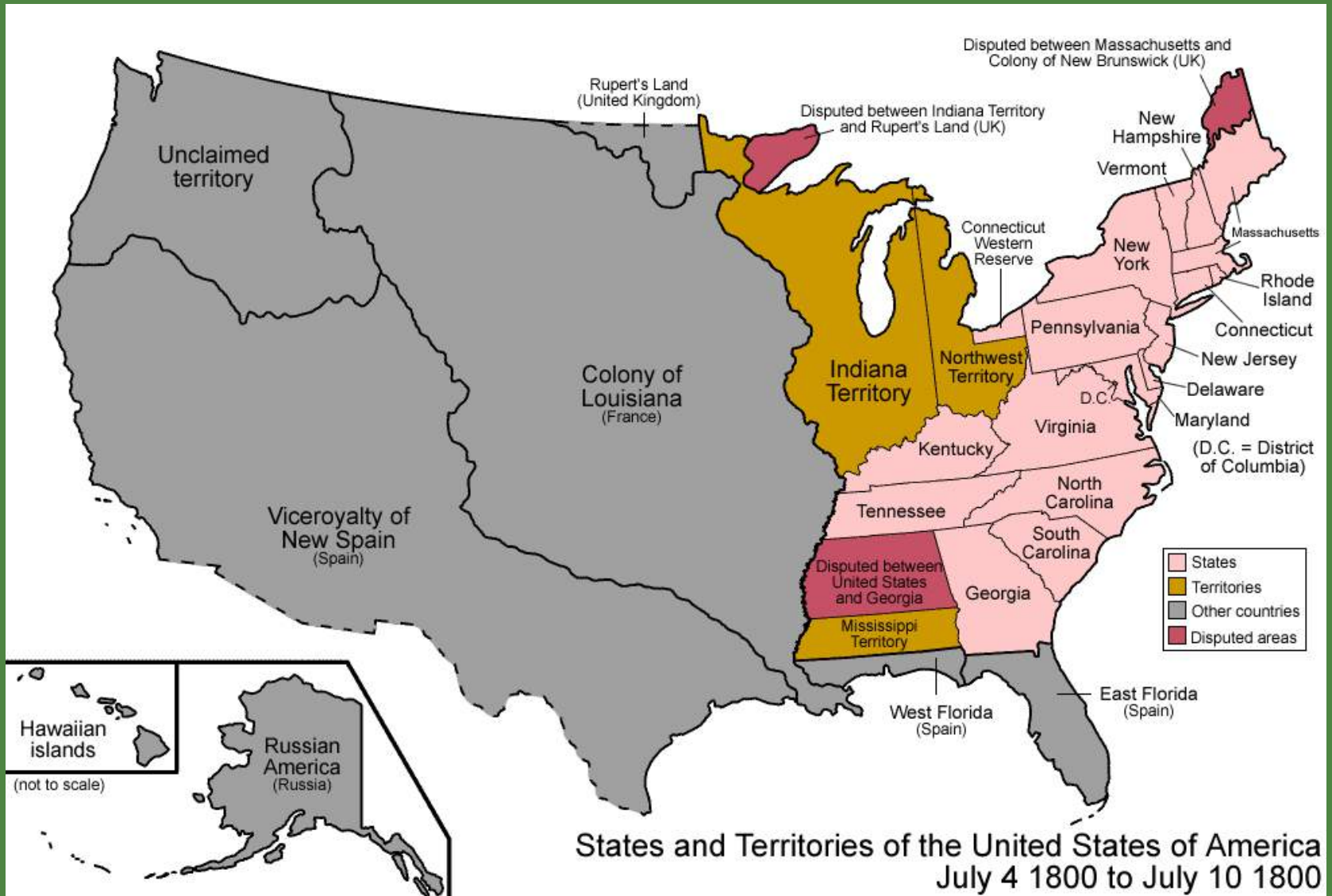


# The Age of Jefferson

# Land Belonging to the United States from 1783 until 1803.

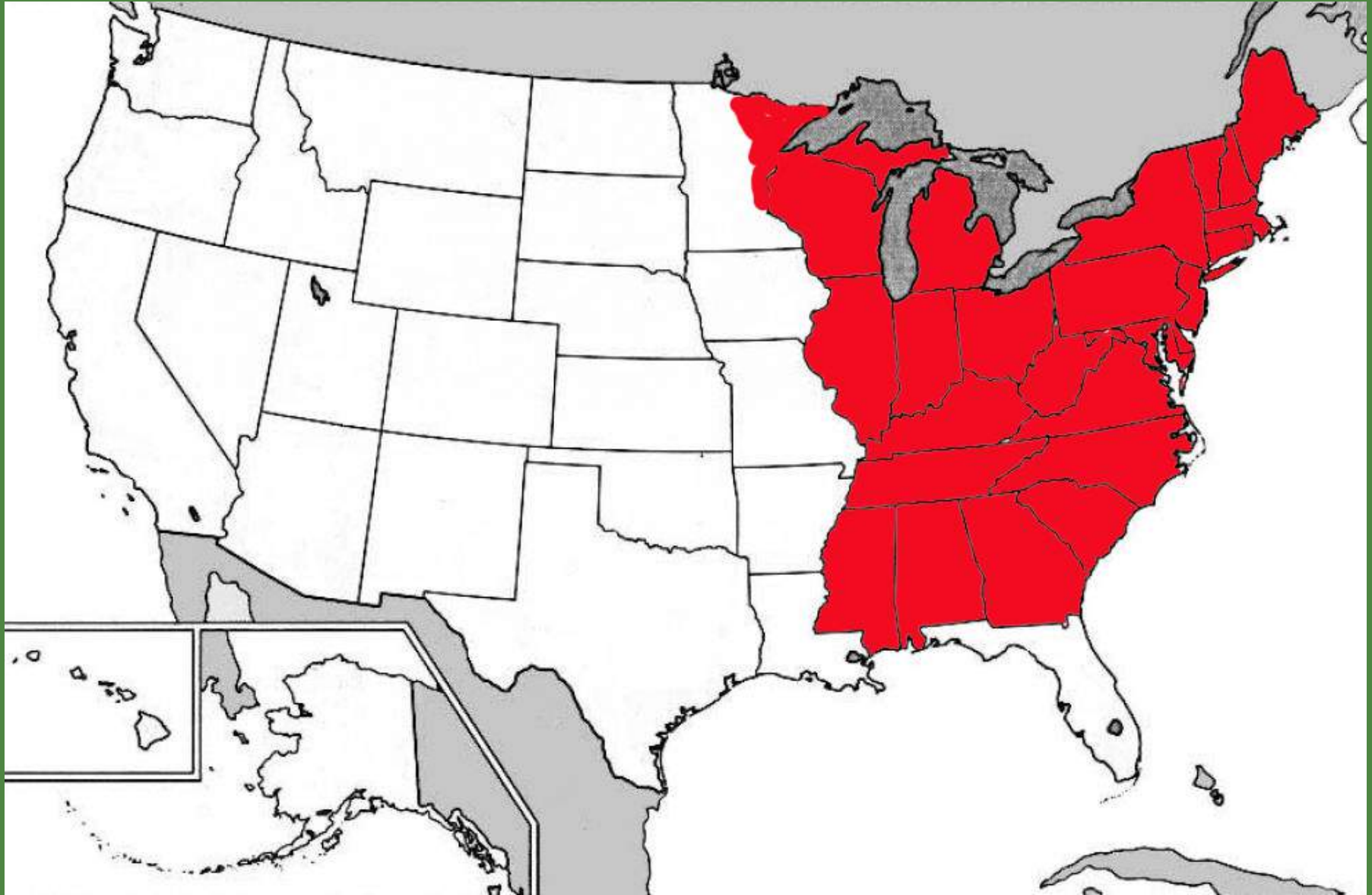
